

1 OBJECTIVE

- a) To establish the rules and requirements for use of all ECCO's trademarks and certification marks.

2 DEFINITION

Terms of Use: are rules by which one must agree to abide in order to use a service.

3 TERMS

The following organizational trademark is owned and administered by ECCO:



- a) ECCO grants permission to use the ECCO's Certification Mark to companies who have achieved a successful audit to one or more standards and have received a Certificate of Compliance from ECCO.
- b) Permission to use the certification mark is limited to the certified person, and shall not be transferred to, assigned to, or otherwise used by any other individual, organization, or entity.
- c) The Client shall use ECCO's Certification Mark in its communication media in such a way as to create no confusion between matters referred to in the scope of certification and other matters, and in no way to imply coverage of any activities outside the scope of certification.
- d) The certified Client shall not use ECCO's Certification Mark for product nor product packaging nor in any other way that may be interpreted as denoting product conformity. The client may put a statement on a product packaging or accompanying information that it has a certified management system. However, this statement cannot claim that the product, process or service is certified. The statement shall include reference to:
 - i. identification (e.g. brand or name) of the certified client;

- ii. the type of management system (e.g. quality, environment) and the applicable standard;
 - iii. the certification body issuing the certificate.
- a) The certified Client shall not use ECCO's Certification Mark for laboratory tests, calibration or inspection reports or certificates.
 - b) ECCO reserves the right to replace the certification mark by another certification mark at any time.
 - c) ECCO's Certification Mark will be delivered to the certified Client for print use only. Other requests shall be handled on a need's basis.

4 VIOLATION OF TERMS

Following receipt of information that an inappropriate or unauthorized use of ECCO's Certification Mark, ECCO will determine if appropriate action(s) will be taken, including the following:

- a) The alleged inappropriate or unauthorized mark use will be reviewed.
- b) The notification to the individual(s) and/or organization(s) involved, requesting that they cease the unauthorized use immediately.
- c) Any legal actions or sanctions including certification suspension or termination.
