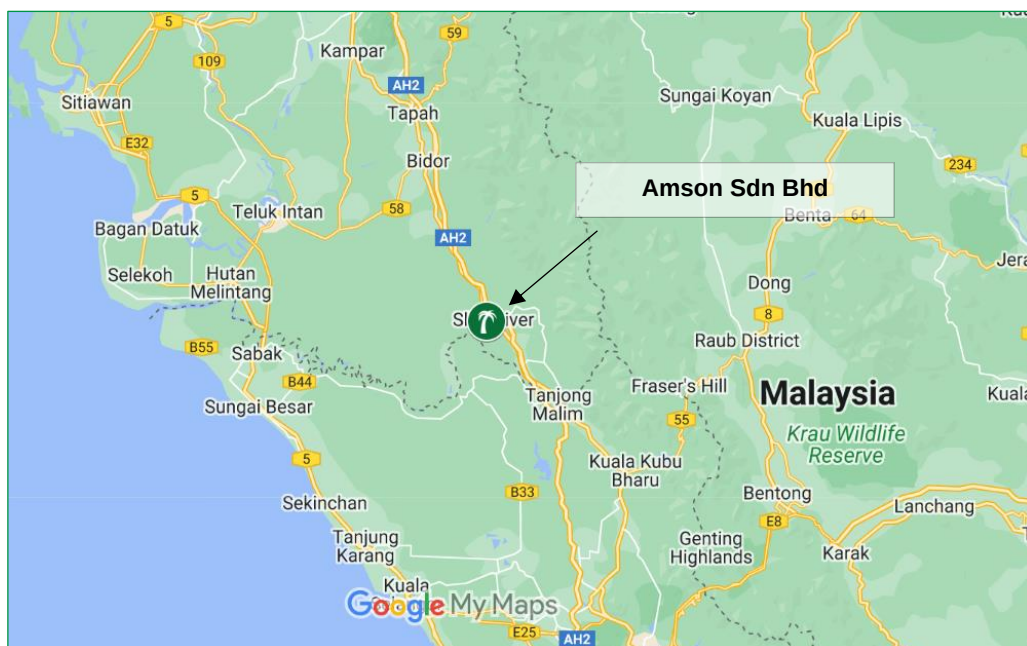


Figure 1: Location of **Amson Sdn Bhd** in Google Map based on its GPS coordinate
