Fermanagh Estate (FME) with a total area of 683.78 Ha was opened for oil palm cultivation in 1956, owned by Southern Realty (Malaya) Sdn Bhd located in Sungai Pelek within Sepang in Selangor. The estate is currently employing a total of 36 local and foreign workers. FME staffs and workers also managing a sister estate, Sepang Pertiwi Estate, sitting next to each other. Crops from FME are supplied to Fermanagh Palm Oil Mill, the mill division of the same company.




Figure 1: Location of Fermanagh Estate in Google Map based on its GPS coordinate




Figure 2: Map of Fermanagh Estate depicting estate boundary, field blocks etc.
