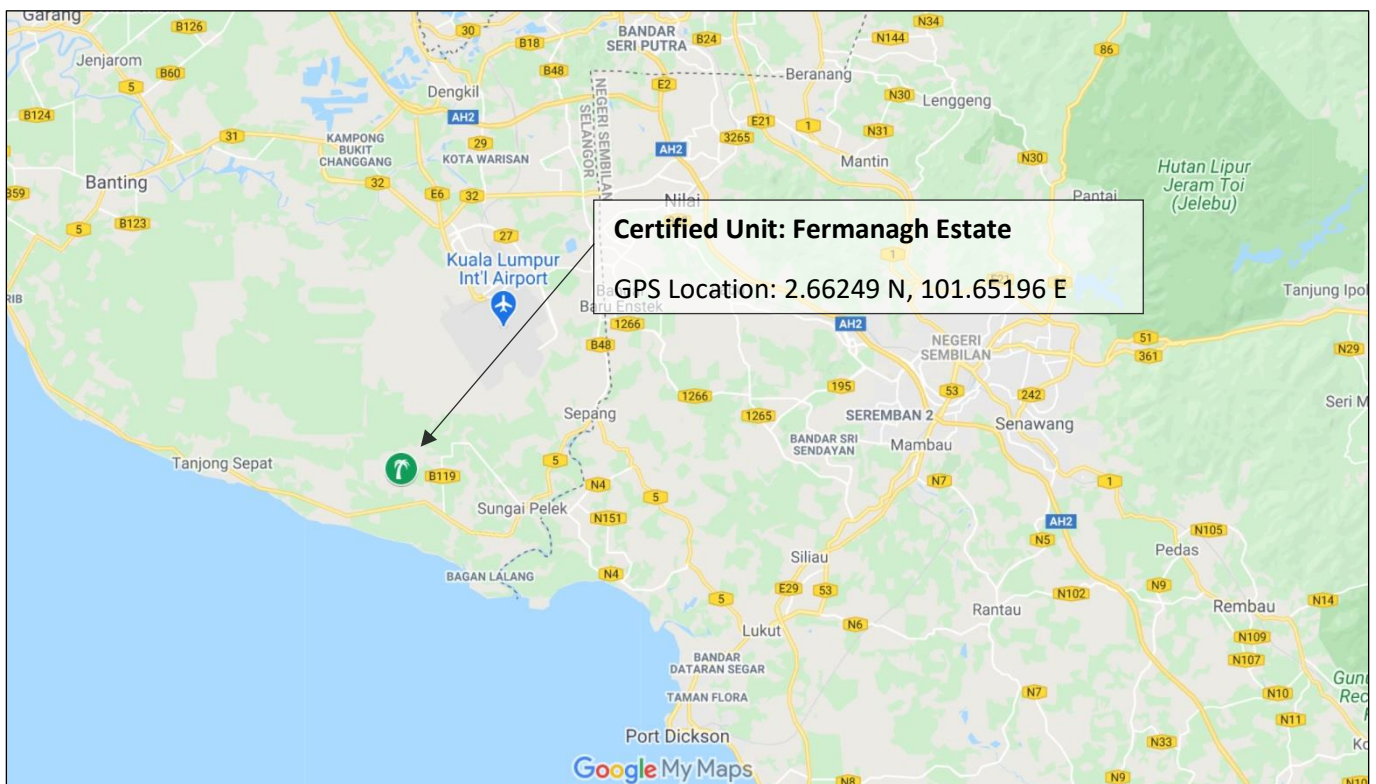


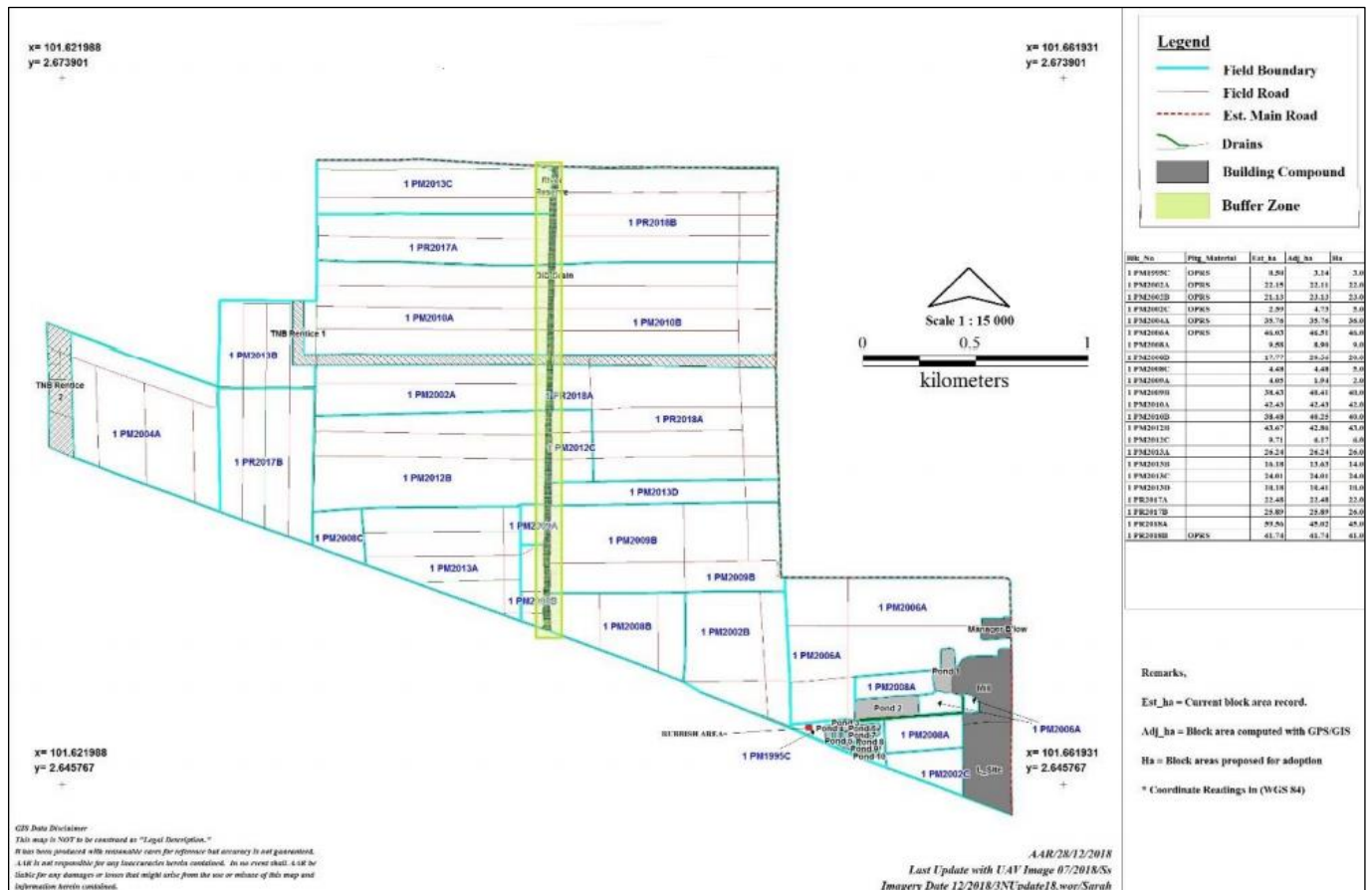
Figure 1: Location of Fermanagh Estate in Google Map based on its GPS coordinate
