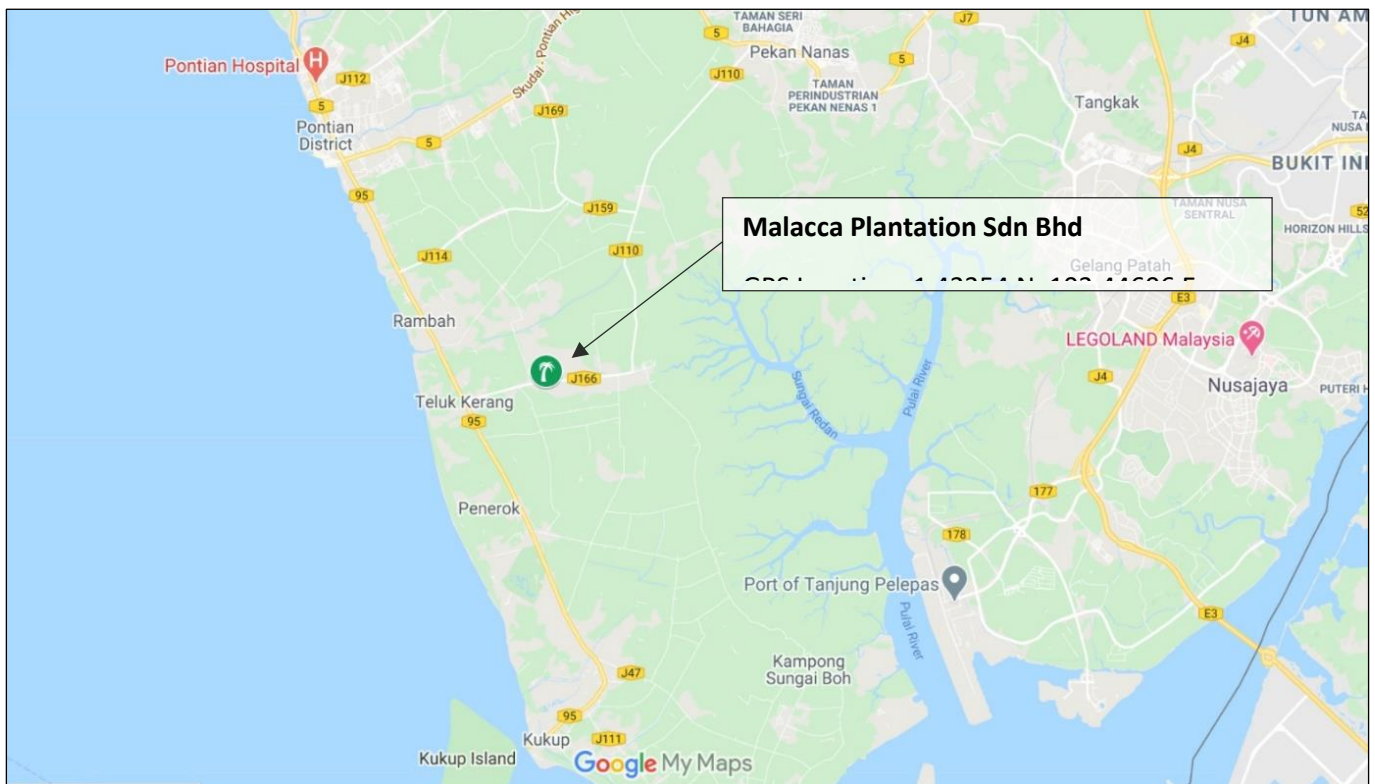


Figure 1: Location of Malacca Plantation Sdn Bhd in Google Map based on its GPS coordinate

The audit evidence obtained were based on samples of information available; thereby introduces the element of uncertainty.
