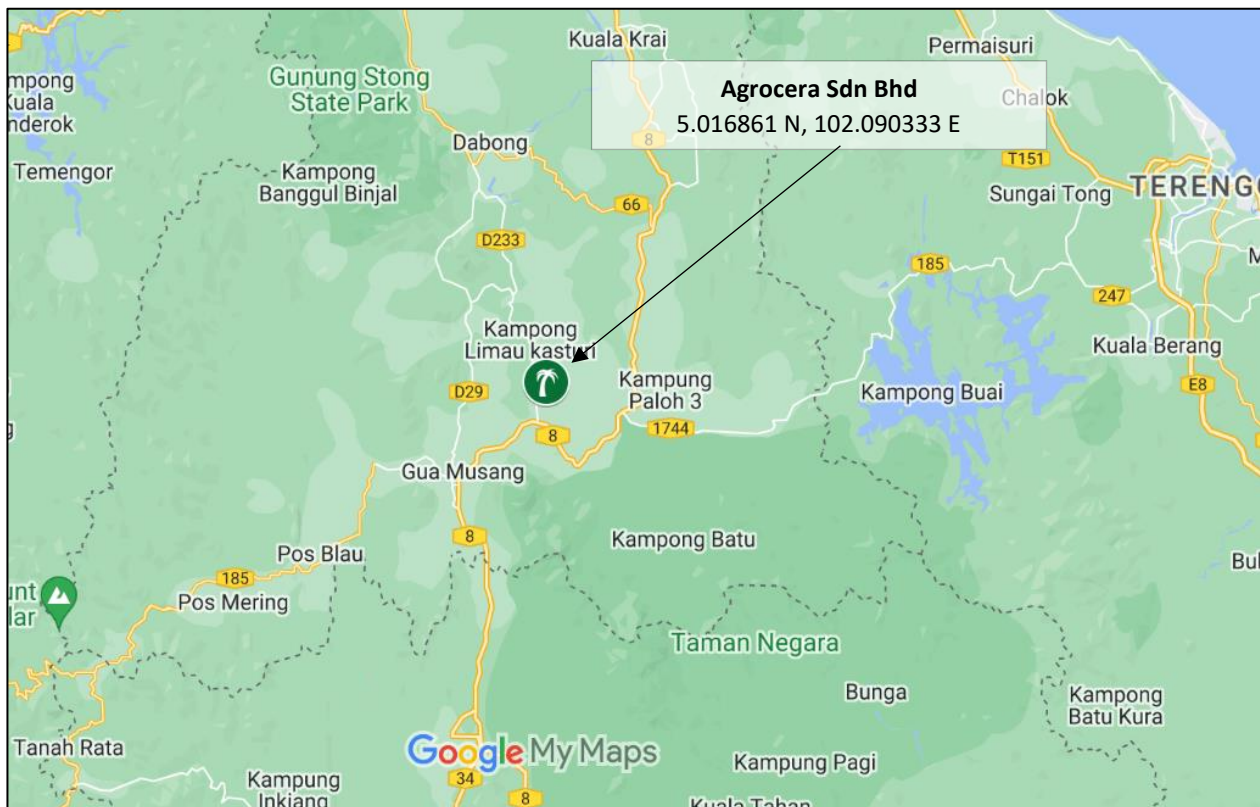


Figure 1: Estate area map of Agrocera Sdn Bhd.

Interviews are done with the management unit's management, employees, contractors and other relevant stakeholders were also conducted during the audit. The audit evidence obtained were based on samples of information available; thereby introduces the element of uncertainty.
Calculation of Sample Size	The sample size is determined by the following formula: $S = r \sqrt{n}$; Whereby S = sample size r = risk factor n = number of members. r is selected as per below: - Low risk: risk factor 1.0 - Medium risk: risk factor 1.5 - High risk: risk factor 2 The lowest possible sample size number is one.
