Mill Introduction

Golconda Palm Oil Mill (GPOM) is located within the mukim of Kapar in the state of Selangor, Malaysia. GPOM was established in June 1972. GPOM is the mill division for the Southern Realty (Malaya) Sdn Bhd and the mill is located within the premise of Golconda Estate, and occupies an area of 13.99 Ha. Currently GPOM throughput is at 30 MT/hour and runs in 2 shifts with a total manpower of 60 people.




Figure 1: Location of the mill in Google Map based on its GPS coordinate.
